Here are some tips to help establish a healthy daily routine for our learners.



<u>Make a schedule:</u> Since school is closed, it is important to reinforce what is done at school, so make a daily routine for kids and ensure they spend some time with books.



Involve them in sorting out clothing items or books shelf.

Encourage story telling - Show and Tell. Tell the kids to <u>speak few lines</u> on the toys they have.

Play with toy collection at home –for eg.- building blocks, play-sets, and puzzles are just a few of the good toys that can keep kids engaged.


Activity #1

- Chocolate/ pineapple/ strawberry syrup


Note- You can take ingredients as per your choice.
