We embark on a fascinating journey to explore about transports and their different types. Through engaging activities and tasks, we aim to deeper our understanding of the invaluable role of different modes of transports in our society.

**General Instructions**

1. Whenever you go out for any task or work or on a trip/vacation, observe different modes of transports you use to travel and segregate them on the basis whether they take you via road, air or water.
2. Draw any one transport you observed and colour it. Also mention type of transport; Land, Water and Air.
3. **Your Own Work**- Do most of the project by yourself. Parents can help explain things, but let your ideas and handwriting be the star.
4. Parents are requested to download Padlet link to upload photographs and videos that is given at the end of the homework.
5. **Due Date**- Finish and turn in your holiday homework by 1st July 2024.

## **Here are some tips to help establish a healthy daily routine for your learners.**

### **Things to do daily:**

- ✚ Wish everyone good morning and good night.
- ✚ Greet your elders everyday.
- ✚ Get up early and do 'OM Chanting' and exercise daily.
- ✚ Recite Gayatri Mantra every morning.
- ✚ Wash your hands before and after meals and brush your teeth daily.
- ✚ Save water by closing taps when not in use and not wasting water unnecessarily.
- ✚ Help your family members daily.
- ✚ Involve your child to read picture story books and colouring on daily basis.
- ✚ Engage your child to play with blocks, puzzles, etc.

## Theme: Transports

### Activity 1:

1. Look out for any three objects at your home that consists '**Standing Line**' in them and click your picture highlighting them. For E.g.- Balcony Railings.
2. Draw any picture using '**Sleeping Lines**' on a sheet. Use creativity to highlight the sleeping lines. For E.g.- Use matchstick/ice-cream stick to highlight sleeping lines.



3. LEAF HUNT: Letter 'L' says Leaf, so let's go for a Leaf Hunt. Collect different types of leaves and take their prints on a sheet of paper.



4. Collect any 5 items from your house that starts with letter 'L'. Make a video naming each one of them along with its sound and share on padlet link.
5. Make a star using '**Slanting lines**' by making use of coloured toothpicks.



6. Create some '**Zig-Zag**' pattern on two different sheets and use a block to trace these patterns with both hands simultaneously.



7. Prepare a water transport scenic craft using different patterns and lines.



### **Activity 2:**

1. It's '**All About Myself**' so, draw a picture of yourself and colour it. Also, learn these 3 lines:
  1. My name is \_\_\_\_\_.
  2. I am a boy/girl.
  3. I am \_\_\_\_\_ years old.
2. Prepare a '**My Family**' tree using handprints of every member and paste their photos and mention their relation with you.



3. Let's do a '**Role Play**' task. You are the teacher for the day and you have to teach the topic- 'My Body' exactly how your teacher teaches. Tell about- hands, legs, eyes, ears, nose and mouth. Also mention their uses.
4. **DRINK-O-LICIOUS DELIGHT DAY**- Let's beat the heat this summer through a delightful drink. Prepare anyone drink from the given video with the help of your mother and enjoy the freshness of this drink with family. Capture the moment in pictures & share on padlet.



5. What is that Mystery Food?- Take few food items like apple, grapes, pineapple, pulses, cauliflower, etc. Try to guess the food items by touching them with your hands while blindfolded.

### **Activity 3:**

1. Take few items and segregate them on the basis of '**Big and Small**'. Click pictures and send. For E.g.- Cricket ball & Football, Spoon & Glass.
2. Collect few items and weigh them through your hand. Segregate them on the basis of '**Heavy and Light**'. Count total number of heavy items and light items separately. Make a video and share on padlet.

Now take a bowl full of water and drop one heavy and one light object in it. Find out what happens with heavy items and light items. You can use the same items that you segregated earlier. For E.g.- Feather & Stone, Toy block & Cotton ball.

#### **Activity 4:**

1. **Paint your canvas-** Paint out your emotions on a sheet canvas by doing a 'Splatter Painting'. You can use a paint brush or a balloon to do this painting.



2. Prepare an attractive cover page of your summer vacation holiday homework folder using different techniques like scribbling, fruit or vegetable prints, patterns or curves, etc. Also label it creatively.

#### **IMPORTANT DAYS & TASKS:**

1. **WORLD MILK DAY (1<sup>st</sup> JUNE):** Visit a dairy farm and observe how we get milk from cow or buffalo. Learn 3 benefits of milk and share video on padlet.
2. **WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY(5<sup>TH</sup> JUNE):** Let's care for environment and do following tasks:
  - A. Plant a quick growing seed and watch it grow from small to big.
  - B. Switch off fans and lights when not in use.
  - C. Throw garbage in the dustbin and keep your surrounding clean.
3. **WORLD FATHER'S DAY (16<sup>TH</sup> JUNE):** Plan and throw a surprise party for your dad with your mother's help. Enjoy this day and click lots of memorable pictures.
4. **INTERNATIONAL PICNIC DAY (18<sup>TH</sup> JUNE):** Create a picnic day setup at your home with food, games OR go out for a picnic with your family and enjoy the day along with your whole family.

5. **INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY (21<sup>ST</sup> JUNE):** Be a yoga instructor for your parents and guide them in performing different asanas as ABC poses.

**A** is for aeroplane Pose  
**B** is for boat/butterfly pose.  
**C** is for cat pose.  
**D** is for downward dog pose.
