# Here are some tips to help establish a healthy daily routine for your learners.

Make a schedule: Since school is closed, it is important to reinforce what is done at school, so make a daily routine for kids and ensure they spend some time with books.



Involve them in shoe lacing and zipping /unzipping.

- Encourage your child to <u>speak the golden words</u> like: sorry, please, thank you, excuse me.
- Encourage story telling Show and Tell. Tell the kids to <u>speak few lines</u> on their favorite food.
  - Pretend Play: It encourages creativity. Give them some toys like kitchen set, dolls, teddies, cars and encourage them to speak in English while playing roles with them.
- Play with toy collection at home for eg. building blocks, play-sets, and puzzles are just a few of the good toys that can keep kids engaged for hour.
- Collect all the plastic waste at your home on daily basis and bring it to school. Click photographs of your collection and share on padlet link. Consider the environmental benefits of reducing plastic consumption and share your thoughts with your peer mates when you return to school.

- 1 cup water (for the simple syrup)
- 1 cup freshly squeezed lemon juice
- 2 to 3 cups cold water, to dilute





# Activity #2 Its healthy & tasty - it's Milk Time (World Milk Day – 1<sup>st</sup> June)Oreo shake Ingredients:

Oreo biscuits, milk, ice-cream, chocolate syrup.

- 1. Crush the Oreos. Just pop them in a plastic bag and bash gently with a rolling pin. That's the cookies *with* the filling!
- **2. Blend ingredients.** Add the milk first, followed by the ice cream, then the cookie crumbs. Blender until smooth.
- **3. Top and garnish.** Pour the shakes into glasses, add a big dollop of whipped cream, and drizzle with chocolate syrup. Pop an extra Oreo on top for that final touch.
- 4. Serve and enjoy. Grab a straw and a spoon, and sip your homemade Oreo milkshake.
